- 1. Based on your career goals choose subjects from pools 1,2,3,4 and 5 respectively
- 2. Only ONE subject must be selected from each pool and **ALL** students must choose a subject from Pool 5. (N.B. you do not have to do more than four subjects therefore one pool may remain empty)
- 3. At least 3 double unit courses must be done if students are desirous of receiving Academic Cords for Hampton School's Graduation (determined by performance).
- 4. Students who plan to pursue courses at U.W.I. **MUST** do Communication Studies and Caribbean Studies in any one of the two years and **three (3)** other double unit subjects.
- 5. It is recommended that students wishing to study in **Canada DO Pure Mathematics**
- 6. **N. B. Students wishing to pursue a CXC Associate Degree are required to do:** Caribbean Studies, Communication Studies, Integrated Mathematics/ One unit of Pure Math, two double unit subjects (core) and three other units (adjunct/ elective) from any other approved CAPE courses. Students should apply for the Associate Degree when they are paying for their respective CAPE subject in grade 13.
