INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING POOL SHEET:

1. Choose **at least 3 subjects** from pools 1- 4 and enter below. **All** students must choose a subject from Pool 5.
2. At least 3 double unit courses must be done if students are desirous of receiving Academic Cords for Hampton School's Graduation (determined by performance).
3. Students who plan to pursue courses at U.W.I. **MUST** do Communication Studies AND Caribbean Studies in any one of the two years and **three (3)** other double unit subjects.
4. Students interested in studying in Canada **MUST** do Pure Mathematics.
5. **Students wishing to pursue a CXC Associate Degree are required to do:** Caribbean Studies, Communication Studies, Integrated Mathematics/one unit of Pure Math, two double unit subjects (core) and three other units (adjunct/elective) from any other approved CAPE courses. *Students should apply for the Associate Degree when they are paying for their respective CAPE subject in grade 13.*
